AN ACT

Amending the act of September 26, 1951 (P.L.1539, No.389), 1 entitled "An act defining clinical laboratory; regulating the 2 operation of the same; requiring such laboratories to obtain 3 permits, and to be operated under the direct supervision of qualified persons; imposing certain duties upon the 5 Department of Health; and providing penalties," further 6 providing for definitions and for exemptions. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of September 26, 1951 11 (P.L.1539, No.389), known as The Clinical Laboratory Act, is 12 amended by adding definitions to read: 13 Section 2. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 14 when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in 15 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 16 17 "Plasma." The fluid portion of human blood. 18 "Plasmapheresis." A procedure in which, during a single visit to a facility, blood is removed from an individual, the 19 source plasma is separated from the formed elements and at least 20

- 1 the red blood cells are returned to the donor.
- 2 <u>"Source plasma donation center." A facility where plasma is</u>
- 3 collected by plasmapheresis and used as a source material for
- 4 <u>further manufacturing use</u>. The term does not include single
- 5 <u>donor plasma products intended for intravenous use.</u>

- 7 Section 2. Section 13 of the act is amended to read:
- 8 Section 13. Exemptions. -- This act shall not include nor
- 9 apply to [any]:
- 10 <u>(1) Any</u> laboratory or laboratories maintained and
- operated by the Federal government[; nor to any].
- 12 <u>(2) Any</u> laboratory or laboratories maintained and
- operated purely for research or teaching purposes.
- 14 (3) Any source plasma donation center that performs only
- 15 hematocrit and total protein donor eligibility tests.
- 16 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
